MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT WHITE

FEBRUARY 12, 2018

The Town Council of the Town of Fort White met in regular business session February 12, 2018 at 7:30 pm. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jackson. On roll call, members present were: Donald Cook, Mary Fleming, Demetric Jackson, Matthew Lance and James Richardson.

Motion to approve the minutes of the meeting of January 8, 2018 as submitted was made/ second. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS None to report

NEW BUSINESS:

CONTRACT RECOMMENDATION: Chad McCormick presented council with a copy of the bid opening by the county for the paving of Durant St. and Brighton Ct.. The low bid accepted by the county was from Curt's Construction in the amount of \$226,221.29. Motion to approve recommendation for Curt's Construction for the paving project of Durant St. and Brighton Ct. was made/second. Motion carried.

SCOP application: Chad McCormick advised that the SCOP application for SW Jordan St. was prepared and ready to be sent to the County for submittal to DOT. A motion was made/second to submit the SCOP application to the County for submittal to DOT was made/second. Motion carried.

RECYCLE: Mayor Jackson advised that the County had contacted him with a request for permission to start a recycling program in the town for residents of the county. He stated that the county would be responsible for the program with the town providing a location for the recycle bins. There was much discussion regarding the program between council and members of the public present. Mayor Jackson stated that with the permission of council he would contact the county and advise that the town was interested in the program and would help as much as feasible. Council agreed. Further details will be available at the meeting in March.
